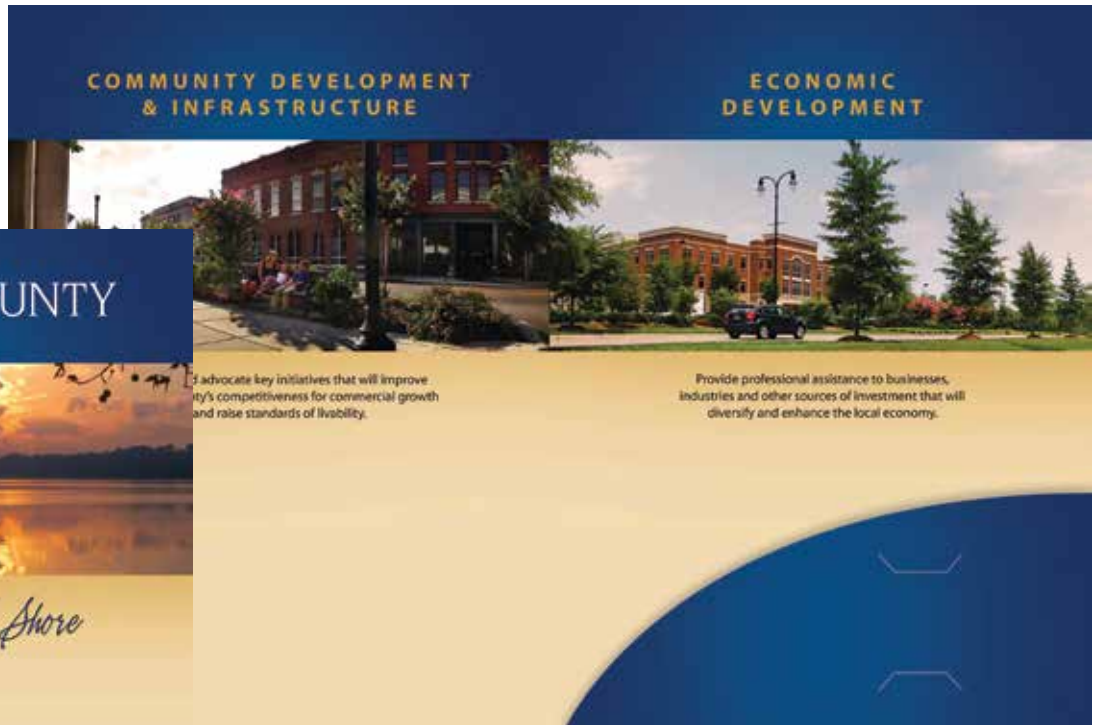
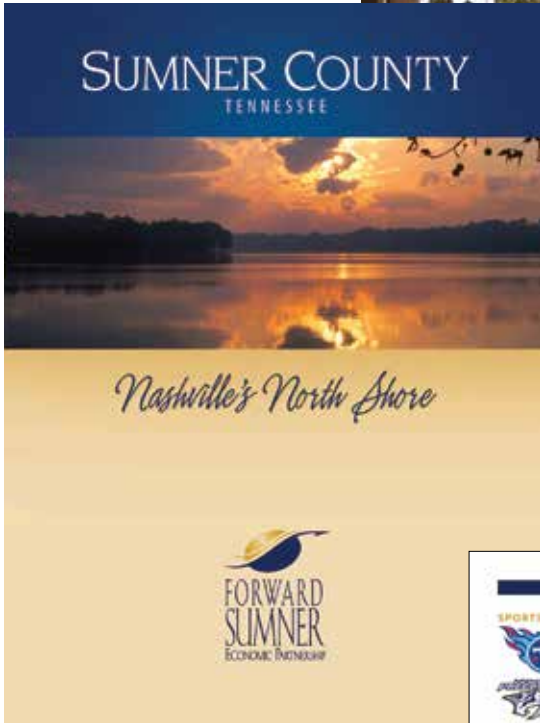

Sumner County offers direct access to the major road corridor with Interstate 40 and the east-west corridor with Interstate 44 and US-58. Other major routes include US-58, US-41, and US-42. Sumner County is the only county in Tennessee with a toll road, the Nashville-Smyrna Expressway (SR-153).

The United States Army Corps of Engineers operates the Nashville Lock and Dam, which offers full-day boating access to the Gulf of Mexico via the Ohio, Tennessee and Mississippi Rivers.

**High Quality** - Sumner County is the birth of many nationally known products and services including Taylor Swift, Johnny and June Carter Cash, Bill Monroe, Country Music, Old Man River, Nashville, New Orleans and the Old Hickory Lake.  
**Preserving the Land** - Sumner County has one of the largest undeveloped lands that have been in continuous operation for over 100 years.  
**Gateway Capital** - Located in Sumner County, the world's largest and most advanced truck and trailer manufacturing plant is located in Sumner County, TN. The plant, which covers the first 100 acres of the site, is currently under construction and is expected to be completed in 2015, and will be one of the largest manufacturing plants in the world.
